Dear Sir,

I have been searching the Postal Commission on the assassination of President Kennedy for the past 3 months in London & wish to advise you that as a result of these searches I can say that the above mentioned was NOT involved in the shooting of President J.F. Kennedy, or Officer Tibbels - he was clearly <sup>persecuted</sup> framed by the conspirators. I have advised that FBI that I took the photograph of man with revolver & air gun which appeared in Life Magazine; he stated advertising agency, Jackson for clothing at 650 Ave. requests in connection with summer of 1958-1959. There is however the plant investigation blooming. Miami stated she took a picture of Dallas Neely Sr. in MARCH & some expert stated that species of plant could not possibly bloom in Miami. I refer to the photograph Vol 17 of the above mentioned book shows different detail. 214 West Neely Sr. Office & Photograph of Buck yard where Miami stated she took photo of General Phillips

I am passing this information as an independent witness & what was a travesty of justice in view of the recently revealed information. Your representative gave testimony before the President Commission Lt Col. Allison Fousom & may be initiated as I have little doubt the Marine Corps could get adverse publicity.

The Director F.B.I. has been advised of my former my letter; if Lt Col. Allison Fousom is still in the Marine Corps he might wish copies of my former letter I send to the F.B.I. as a reference to assess the evidence which I am sure you will find conclusive in that Lt Fousom was "framed" for both shootings of President Kennedy & the assassination.
