Enclosed for the information of the Bureau are three Photostatic copies of a letter written by General HERBERT C. HOLDRIDGE, Brigadier General, U. S. Army (Retired).

The above letter was received by SA HENRY F. ALSTON from [redacted] Printing Company, Laguna Beach, California on 12/5/63. [redacted] advised that HOLDRIDGE is a regular customer and has a running account with the company amounting to approximately \$80 per month.

HASTIE further advised that his company did not print the enclosed letter. He explained that HOLDRIDGE came into his office on 12/2/63 and wanted it printed immediately, but he was unable to handle this request. He stated that HOLDRIDGE subsequently went to a company in Sherman Oaks, California where he had it printed and dropped off a copy with [redacted] [redacted] concluded by stating in his opinion HOLDRIDGE is a "mental case".
