The Bureau report on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, which was delivered to the President's Commission on 12/5/63, included a number of exhibits which contained known handwriting of Lee Harvey Oswald. In our discussions with Mr. J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel for the Commission, Mr. Rankin observed that the members of the Commission had encountered some difficulty in reading Oswald's handwriting and it would be most helpful if typewritten copies of the handwriting could be prepared.

Typewritten copies of the exhibits containing Oswald's handwriting were prepared and on 12/24/63, 14 copies of this material were delivered in person by Inspector Malley to the Commission. This number represents the number of copies of the report which have been previously delivered to the Commission.
