Presidential Commission

Chief of the Secret Service James Rowley called and advised me that Inspector Kelly had delivered the Secret Service report to the Commission to Mr. Leo Harkin and had come back with an itinerary for Chief Justice Warren who is going to the West Coast. He indicated a copy of the itinerary would be sent to me. Mr. Harkin had asked who would take care of the Chief Justice while he is on the West Coast.

I told Mr. Rowley I thought the Secret Service should do this. Mr. Rowley agreed and stated Secret Service has experienced men on the West Coast who can handle this. He said he would advise Mr. Harkin of the decision we had reached.

I inquired if Mr. Rowley had seen David Lawrence's column in the New York Herald Tribune this morning. He had not seen the column and I told him it was a very fine article about the Secret Service and FBI and denied all the lies that have been printed. I further advised him that it may be in the Washington Star this evening. He indicated that he would get both papers and thanked me for this information.
