Lee Rankin, Counsel for the President's Commission, has advised that the Commission will utilize the services of Albert Jenner, a Chicago lawyer who resides at Evansion, Illinois, and is presently confined to the Evanston Hospital in Room 4126. Mr. Rankin advised that Mr. Jenner would be confined for at least a week or more and that the Commission was most desirous that a 1 copy of the report on the "Investigation of Assassination of President John F. Kennedy, November 22, 1963," as well as the report covering the "Investigation of Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald, Dallas, Texas, November 24, 1963," along with three volumes of exhibits, be made available to Mr. Jenner for his review while he is confined in the hospital. Enclosed are the two reports referred to above, along with three volumes of exhibits, for transmittal to Mr. Jenner at the Evanston Hospital, Evanston, Illinois. In discussing this matter with a representative of the Bureau, Mr. Rankin stated that the security of these reports would be no problem. It is requested that when these reports are delivered and to Mir. Jenner, it be pointed out to him the necessity that these reports be maintained in a confidential basis.
