SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA

By letter dated 1/6/64, J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel, President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy, referred a letter he thought was in Spanish to the Director, which the Commission requested be translated so that the contents could be evaluated.

It was determined that the letter was in the Portuguese language. The letter is from a General Protero, P. O. Box 20, Amadora, Portugal. He claims he has written a book disclosing a conspiracy behind the assassination of President Kennedy. He is willing to make the information available if the Commission helps him to find a publisher in the United States.
