Dear Lee:

We have received the following anonymous letter which was postmarked at Saint Petersburg, Florida, on January 5, 1964.

"Ruben shot Oswald fraid he talk to much he chicken they work togethr hire frum California jews We here to get Martin Luthr King and Wilkson and Mayr Allan We wont miss no. Two more in Washington to get Bob Kenedy and 2 nigers then johnson if he push intergratin We plege not fall or die We not fall no."

"Wilkson" may refer to Roy Wilkins, Executive Secretary of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, and "Mayr Allan" may refer to Ivan Allen, Jr., Mayor of Atlanta, Georgia.

Appropriate investigation is being instituted by the FBI and in view of the threat against the President, the text of the letter has been furnished to the United States Secret Service. We have also advised the Attorney General and the Atlanta, Georgia, Police Department of the contents of the letter.
