SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA.
IS - R - CUBA

As you were advised by my memorandum of 12/19/63, necessary arrangements have been made with the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) to process (by neutron activation analysis) the paraffin casts from Lee Harvey Oswald for powder residues, and preliminary work is already in progress at Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

Under the arrangements made, Dr. Glenn T. Seaborg, Chairman, AEC, agreed to fully cooperate in this matter and also agreed that the FBI should have complete control of the examinations and the results therefrom. Dr. Spofford G. English, Assistant General Manager for Research and Development, AEC, was designated to coordinate the matter for AEC.

Dr. English called SA John F. Gallagher today to advise that Dr. Seaborg now has a letter from Chief Justice Earl Warren requesting any information AEC might have or will develop in the near future on the Oswald case. To be responsive to the inquiry, Dr. Seaborg feels that he will have to report that AEC and the FBI are conducting tests on the paraffin casts from Oswald. Furthermore, Dr. Seaborg would like to advise that any data obtained from these tests would be reported by the FBI.

Pursuant to coordination of this matter with you, Dr. English was advised that the Bureau has no objection to an AEC response along the lines indicated.

Dr. English advised that he would furnish the Bureau a copy of Dr. Seaborg's letter to Chief Justice Warren.
