Reference is made to your memorandum of January 20, 1964, regarding the furnishing of investigative reports to Dallas County District Attorney Wade.

In accordance with the discussion held between Mr. Foley of your Division and Mr. Malley of the FBI on January 21, 1964, we are making available to United States Attorney Barefoot Sanders in Dallas one copy of each of the 13 reports which have been furnished to you in this case. Prior to giving the reports to Mr. Sanders, we will remove the items specified for deletion in your memorandum.

An additional report dated January 17, 1964, at Dallas, is being forwarded to you as soon as we have completed reviewing it. It is understood that you will then review this report to determine whether any of the information in it should be made available to Mr. Wade and that future investigative reports will be handled in the same manner.

It is also understood that the President's Commission is cognizant of the manner in which the information is being made available to Mr. Wade.
