Enclosed are the original and two copies of a memorandum setting forth the FBI's response to date concerning an inquiry made by HSCA Chief Counsel and Staff Director, Mr. G. Robert Blakey, on November 11, 1977.

Mr. Blakey expressed the concern of certain HSCA staff members that a page in a December 23, 1963, Dallas Division report may have been redone during preparation to omit the name of Special Agent (SA) James P. Hosty which was contained in an address book belonging to Lee Harvey Oswald.

SA John F. Kesler and former SA Robert P. Gemberling have testified before the Committee on this point. On December 1, 1977, Congressman Louis Stokes, Chairman, HSCA, provided transcripts of their testimony for our review and internal use only. These are available to you should you desire. An FD-302 reflecting interview of HSCA staffers is included in the memorandum and it substantially summarizes the information contained in the transcripts.

It is the FBI's intent, with your concurrence, to pursue this matter and conduct interviews of logical persons as warranted in an effort to develop additional information that may explain why a page of the questioned report may have been redone.

You will be kept advised of the results of this inquiry.
