On August 7, 1978, [redacted] telephone number [redacted] provided the following information, which she felt might be pertinent to the current investigation concerning the John Kennedy assassination. [redacted] had recently read in the newspaper that some investigation was occurring in Atlanta, Georgia.

In the fall of 1967, [redacted] was a student and part-time employee of [redacted]. The General Manager of this office was [redacted] who she described as [redacted]. The main office of [redacted] was located in [redacted].

One Saturday afternoon, [redacted] entered [redacted] Office and he appeared very despondent and depressed. During the conversation that followed, [redacted] informed [redacted] that he used to be a vice president for [redacted] but because he was aware of certain information concerning the John Kennedy assassination conspiracy, [redacted] had been removed from his prestigious job as a vice president and forced to accept a menial job as general manager for [redacted].

[redacted] stated the conspiracy to assassinate John Kennedy involved broadcasting executives in Atlanta, Georgia and Texas, which probably included Lyndon B. Johnson. An unnamed individual, who was involved with the assassination, had stayed in the Mark Inn, Atlanta, Georgia, two days prior to the assassination. [redacted] cautioned [redacted] that he

felt his life was in danger and he did not want to tell [REDACTED] anymore information concerning the conspiracy because he felt [REDACTED] life might be in danger.

[REDACTED] explained that he felt his phone was being monitored and he was under physical surveillance by individuals in a floral truck. [REDACTED] car were forced off the road in Rockhill, North Carolina. When [REDACTED] worked in Atlanta, he lived near [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] owed [REDACTED] a large sum of money that they would not send to him. [REDACTED] was afraid to return to Atlanta to obtain his money.

[REDACTED] stated that although [REDACTED] acted very paranoid during their discussion, she felt [REDACTED] honestly felt there was a conspiracy involved in the Kennedy assassination. [REDACTED] stated that because of [REDACTED] sincerity and his fear concerning the conspiracy, she has been reluctant to advise anyone of their conversation, except her husband.

[REDACTED] also advised [REDACTED] of the details concerning the conspiracy.

[REDACTED] stated she would fully cooperate with the current investigation and she is willing to be hypnotized, if necessary, to help her recall more information concerning the conversation she had with [REDACTED]
