These meetings were held in Atlanta, Georgia, on May 22, 1960, in Orlando, Florida, on July 17, 1960, and in Stone-Mountain, Georgia, on September 3 and 4, 1960. Informant

has been able to report in detail on the activities of these meetings, wherein the Klan has established a national Ku Klux Klan group which has been meeting every two or three months. Informant is temporary National Adjutant of this organization and has been invited to attend their next meeting, scheduled for October 23, 1960, in Savannah, Georgia.



As a result of the informant's strength within the Klan and using his position with the USEA, he is in a position to go to any one of several southeastern states and obtain pertinent and confidential information of value to the Bureau.

### 11. Stability and Reliability

He has not demonstrated or displayed any personal weaknesses, emotional instability, untrustworthiness or unreliability. He has no domestic or personal problems that would cause embarrassment to the Bureau.

## 12. Indoctrination Against Disclosure

Every opportunity has been taken to properly indoctrinate this informant against making any disclosure of the relationship between him and the Bureau through any media. He is well aware of this.

### 13. All Necessary Action Taken on Information Furnished

Information furnished by this informant is given prompt and necessary action and dissemination by the Miami Office.

## 14. Miscellaneous .

Informant also picks up occasional bits of criminal information. This is incidental to his work in racial field.

Based on your recommendation, authority is hereby granted to pay captioned informant up to \$50 per week for services plus up to \$15 per week for expenses actually incurred for a period of four months, effective 9/27/60. A review of captioned informant's file discloses that despite prior expressions of disapproval by the Bureau as to paying the informant the full amount authorized each week you continue to regularly pay him \$50 weekly for services rendered. As you know, payments to informants are to be made on a strict C.O.D. or expense basis and are to be commensurate with the worth of the information furnished or service rendered by the informant. It does not seem logical that an informant will furnish information or render services week in and week out which can be regularly valued at an equal amount.

You are reminded that it is your responsibility as SAC to make certain the Bureau receives full value for all monies paid to this informant and that his payments have not become a mere habitual rendering of \$50 each week without due regard to the value of his activities in our behalf.

The Bureau observes that item number seven of your payment letters, the paragraph relating to the number of reports submitted by the informant, does not set forth the information called for. The statement that the informant furnishes oral information almost daily is not responsive and the Bureau desires to know the actual number of reports submitted by him during the period.
