Somersett had shown him a Photostat of a letter. Somersett, who is active in klan matters, is an informant of our Miami Office, said the Photostat was of a letter he had sent to and also said Somersett stated he got the Photostat from a friend in the FBI at Miami. therefore, believes must be an FBI informant.

This has also been found to be untrue since the Miami Office never had a Photostat of the letter and it was never discussed with or exhibited to Somersett by any Agent.

believes there is a Bureau informant in his organization as based on information he had obtained from Somersett. I reportedly stated Somersett had told him verbatim details of a klan meeting at which Somersett was not present.

Cur investigation of this disclosed that a Miami Agent discussed with Somersett in very general terms two points in connection with the meeting in question. However, the substance of the meeting was not discussed with Somersett in detail and, based on this, he could not have reported verbatim what took place.

He is a member of this organization and firmly entrenched with the Klan leadership.



- A) Furnishes partial coverage on approximately ten Klan leaders throughout the State of Florida and approximately eight Klan leaders residing outside the State of Florida.
- B) Furnishes coverage on four potential bombing suspects residing in Miami, Florida, and two residing in Belle Glade, Florida.
- C) Furnishes coverage on approximately ten individuals who are not members of any Klan but are individuals opposed to integration.

10) INFORMANT'S POTENTIAL FOR ADVANCEMENT

Informant's potential is very good. He has a strong position in the NKKK, which has strengthened his effectiveness in Florida. As a result of the informant's strength within the Klan and using his position with the United Southern Employees Association, he is in a position to go to any one of several SoutheasterntStates and obtain pertinent and confidential information of value to the Bureau.

This informant has also been utilized in developing intelligence information in the labor movement, as well as in hoodlum activities in Miami and Miami Beach.

Miami is aware that this informant does not attend Klan meetings on a regular basis, as is the case of most Klan informants; however this informant is one of the few Klan informants who possesses the ability, availability, incentive, and appropriate cover to go anywhere in the Southeast section of the United States concerning Bureau matters. He is also personally acquainted with a large number of various political figures throughout the Southeast part of the United States, as well as a large number of Klansmen and hoodlums.

11) STABILITY AND RELIABILITY

He has not demonstrated or displayed any personal weaknesses, emotional instability, untrust-worthiness or unreliability. He has no domestic or personal problems that would cause embarrassment to the Bureau.

12) INDOCTRINATION AGAINST DISCLOSURE

Every opportunity has been taken to properly indoctrinate this informant against making any disclosure of the relationship between him and the Bureau through any media. He is well aware of this.

13) ALL NECESSARY ACTION TAKEN ON INFORMATION FURNISHED

Information furnished by this informant is given prompt and necessary action and dissemination by the Miami Office.

MISCELLANEOUS

Informant continues to pick up information regarding criminal matters, and it is believed with increased expense money he will be able to substantially increase his activities and productivities in Miami and Miami Beach. It is expected he will be in a position to furnish considerable anti-racketeering information. This, of course, will be in addition to his work in the racial



The settlement goes on to provide that U.S.E.A. Local #1 shall be dissolved and that all negotiation agreements with contractors and its members be cancelled. Also, that the U.S.E.A., so far as the operations complained of in Florida are concerned, be 'disestablished' which means that future organizational activities must not allow any locals to organize with employer members.

As a matter of law, nothing contained in this stipulation of settlement can restrain or abridge the rights of U.S.E.A. members or any other persons to organize for collective bargaining purposes. These rights are guaranteed by the National Labor Relations Act and the Supreme Court of the United States.

"Freedom of self organization persists, however, notwithstanding the order of the Board commanding the employer to disestablish the company or independent union. The order will not prevent the same employees from immediately reorganizing themselves as an independent union, even though under the same constitution and with the same leaders, provided they do so freely, of their own choice, and are not influenced or overtly approved by the employer."

Informant goes on to say that in his opinion

NLRB, Miami, is trying to expose him and the U.S.E.A. as being Communist dominated and a front for the KKK. According to informant, is doing this to aid and assist Local 349 which is in competition with U.S.E.A.

CI stated he believes 349 has "something" on to make do this. He said that is presently contacting various contractors in the Miami area and advising them that the U.S.E.A. has been disestablished as a Labor Union in the State of Fla.
