PERSONNEL MATTER

On 10/6/64, ASAC KYLE G. CLARK and I had a conference with SA HOSTY. It was pointed out to him that it was extremely desirable not to have any publicity concerning this suspension. He assured both me and ASAC CLARK that he was not going to mention that to anyone except his wife. He did note that of course, once he was transferred or made any inquiries concerning selling his house or removal of his children from school, that this phase of the matter would be bound to come out, but it was again reiterated to him that it was obvious that some of the neighbors had furnished information to the newspapers in the past and that he should be extremely discreet in any discussions he had with the neighbors.

SA HOSTY was also advised that the telephone operators in the office, when calls were received for him, would state that he is not here at present and would attempt to get the name and telephone number of the person calling and he would thereafter be advised.

It was again reiterated that any contact by news media should be answered with no comment concerning his personal situation.
