

SUMMARY FROM SPANISH

Letter to Mr. Robert F. Kennedy from:

Hilario Rojas V.

Calle Manuel Acuna 1367

Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico

undated (postmarked January 21, 1964).

The writer claims he has important information to impart on the assassination of President Kennedy. He complains that he wrote previously, but that he did not receive a reply to his letter. He goes on to state that he was interviewed by minor officials of the United States Embassy, but that he did not tell them anything because the questions they asked him were of no consequence. He does not want to speak with intermediaries. He wants to be issued a special passport and speak with Mr. Robert F. Kennedy personally.
