b7D [redacted] of the [redacted] telephoned today to advise that he had been listening to a Cuban radio station and heard an interview of MARK LANE, the New York attorney who had associated himself with subject's mother, by a Czech reporter. He received the impression that this was a taped interview. He advised that LANE followed the "Communist Line" on the assassination of President KENNEDY, explaining this by saying that LANE ~~had~~ claimed that RUBIN and the slain policeman had been seen together before the assassination, etc.

b7D [redacted] stated he was certain that some agency was monitoring this broadcast but desired to pass this information on for whatever value it might have.
