

For record purposes the following is a summary of telephone calls to or from the Bureau during the period the representatives of the Presidential Commission were in Mexico City, 4/8-13/64.



Mr. SULLIVAN approved the showing of our 3/26/64 memorandum since it had been approved at the Bureau and sent to the Commission in Washington. He advised that review of the 4/7/64 memorandum at the Bureau had not been completed, but that as soon as this was done he would advise telephonically concerning permission to show it to the representatives.

On 4/10/64 at 6:20 p.m., Supervisor JOHN STOKES at the Bureau telephonically advised that review of the 4/7/64 memorandum had been completed and that a copy of the memorandum would be sent forward to the Commission in Washington on


