D. All Spanish names or words should be placed in apostrophes and translated or explained thereafter between parentheses.

E. Any information which is lengthy or complicated should be organized in some logical manner as to topic, sequence of events, etc., and should be separated by sub-headings.

F. The Bureau has emphasized that all communications for dissemination in this matter should be meticulously prepared and "letter perfect" and every care should be used to avoid slang, questionable syntax, and any assumption of background knowledge on the part of the reader.

3. In addition to captioned file, this office also maintains a file entitled "ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, 11/22/63, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING," MC file No. 89-6, and special reporting instructions have been furnished by the Dallas Office (origin) in connection with that case. Those instructions, which are complicated and lengthy, are found in 105-3702, serial 521, the salient points thereof being that all information relating thereto should be submitted in the form of 25 copies of an insert for Dallas; no "T" symbols are to be used; and the information should bear a topic heading or sub-title on the insert. An example of such an insert is serial 82 of MC file 89-6.
