Reference is made to Little Rock teletype to Bureau dated January 6, 1977; Newark teletype to Bureau dated February 2, 1977 and Mexico City teletype to Bureau dated January 10, 1977. Referenced communications are captioned House Select Committee on Assassinations.

For the information of the recipient offices, the FOIPA Branch at the Bureau is engaged in processing, under the provisions of the FOIPA, investigative file materials relating to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy and the FBI's subsequent investigation in this matter.

Requester, [REDACTED], is one of numerous scholars of the Kennedy Assassination with long-standing FOIPA requests pending at the Bureau. His particular area of interest is the relationship between the FBI and Lee Harvey Oswald. [REDACTED] has specifically requested information from the files of your office on Lee Harvey Oswald as described in your referenced communication (Bufile 105-82222, LR 105-406, NK 105-15271 and MK 105-3702).
