

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (UPI) - A rederal district judge dismiss ci todiay a civil suit brought by Jaines Earl Ray against two former attorneys and Aläbama author William Eradiord Huie
U.S. District Jurige William E. Miller took thic action after hearing arguments from three attorney's in the case. Ray and tine defendants were not present.

Miller said Ray did not have the right to birg the suit in the Middle Ternessee Division of federal cenrs but that the case con!d be brought in the Mempinis district.
The suit involves Ray's attempts to void certain contracts and businces arrangements with altorneys percy Foreman of Houston and Arthur J. Hancs of Birmingham, Ala., and Huie.
Ray is serving a 83 -year sentence in the state prison here in the murder of Dr . Martin Iuther King Jr, in Memphis Apirl 4, 193 S.
