## Deposition Taken From Ray For Suit

NASHVILLE, Nov. 22. -(UPI) - A deposition was takon Saturday from convicted assasin James Earl Ray in connection with a federal court suit he filed against two former attorneys and an Alabama author.

John J. Hooker Sr., a Nash-ville attorney, said Texas attorney Percy Foreman, who is named in the suit, was present while the deposition was taken from Ray

Hooker is Foreman's attorncy in the proceedings brought by the convicted slayer of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr.

Also named in the suit are William Bradford Huie, an Alabama author, and attorney Arthur J. Banes Sr. of Bir-mingham, Ray's first attorney after he was arrested in the King slaying.

Ray is seeking to void contracts with the men cencerning rights to his story which was written by Hale and published! in a national magazine.

Hooker said the deposition; was being taken in the maximum security building of the State Penitentiary where Ray is heing hold.
