Mr. WILLIAM ANSCHUTZ, Room 4-B, 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, Tennessee, advised that he recalls the afternoon of April 4, 1968, when Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING was shot and he recalls further that immediately after this shot, he saw a man run past his door at 4-B, 422½ South Main Street, but Mr. ANSCHUTZ did not see enough of this man's face to state whether or not it in any way resembles the artist's conception drawing being shown to him by SA RALPH J. LIEWER. This artist's conception drawing is one which was prepared by GEORGE C. MUMFORD, Exhibits Specialist, Exhibits Section, FBI, Washington, D. C., from a description furnished by Mr. RALPH M.
