Captain RUSSELL V. WARNER, owner and operator of Warner and Tamble, foot of Union Street, Memphis, Tennessee, was interviewed in the presence of Lt. JAMES HAMBY, Homicide Bureau, Memphis Police Department.

Captain WARNER advised that at this address are the following companies which he also owns and operates:

Warner and Tamble Barge Line Corporation;
 Wolf River Transportation Company, Inc.;
 Warner Barge Company, Inc.;
 R. V. Warner Transportation Company;
 Warner Radio Service, Inc.;
 Warner and Tamble Radio Service, Inc.

Captain WARNER advised his firm is one of the largest, if not the largest, barge company in the Memphis area that hires non-union as well as union personnel. He stated he tries to interview each employee after they are hired, or at least get to see them while they are working for any one of these companies. Captain WARNER made available the various companies' personnel and/or payroll records, and it was determined none of the employees are named GALT, LEMEYER, WILLARD, or variations of these names.

Captain WARNER was shown a composite picture of the individual believed to be using the name JOHN WILLARD, and he advised that he does not recall an individual ever working for him in any one of these companies, or anyone making application for employment who resembled this composite picture.

Captain WARNER advised that his main source of employees, other than those who just make application by themselves, are obtained through Waterways Marine, Inc., foot of Beale Street, Memphis, Tennessee.

Captain WARNER advised that if he receives any information concerning an individual making application for employment who is using the name of GALT, LEMEYER, or WILLARD, he will immediately furnish this information to the FBI.
