BILL DAVIS, 2136 Semmes, Memphis, Tennessee, registered April 7, 1968, driving Ford, Tennessee license JC8336;

A. W. DENLSON, Coldwater, Mississippi, registered April 2, 1968, driving Ford, Mississippi license W2451.
