EDGAR E. COCKRELL, owner, Park Layne Motel,
3073 Lamar Avenue, furnished the following information:

He stated that his records failed to reflect the fact that any of his bedspreads were missing which were similar or identical with the one left by subject on S. Main Street, Memphis. He further advised that his records failed to reflect the names HARVEY LOWMEYER and JOHN WILLARD for the dates March 1, 1968, through April 8, 1968. Mr. COCKRELL said that his records reflect the fact that an ARTHUR C. FEATHERSTON of 3558 Pine Needle, Marietta, Georgia, registered at his motel April 1, 1968, and checked out the following day. He said that FEATHERSTON was driving a Ford of unknown year with the license number 7810667.

COCKRELL advised that he was unable to recall FEATHERSTON and could not furnish a physical description.
