J. W. GRIFFIX, Owner, Lindon Lodge, 178 Linden, Memphis, made available the registration cards for his hotel from April 1, 1988, to April 10, 1888. In examination of these cards revealed the following people who could have some connection with the suspect of this case:

CARL B. LAUFER 7 Mountainview Drive, Clifton, New Jersey. In UFER checked into the Linden Lodge on April 3, 1968, and checked out on April 4, 1968. He was driving a Ford Mustang, New Jersey license MSR 119.

WILLIAM E. REYMOLDS, Moute 1, Barnaville, Mississippi.
REYNOLDS checked in on April 4, 1968, and checked out april 5, 1968
He was driving a Ford, Myssissippi license X1126.

LARRY MEITH, Box 341, Boston, Georgia. MEITH registered on April 3, 1968, and left on April 7, 1983, without paying his bill. He listed his employer as Mississippi Valley Barge Lines. GRIFFIN described MRITH as six feet tall, light brown hair, which was long and curly, and he were a mustache.

Examination of the above-mentioned registration cards revealed that ERIC STARVO GALT, JOHN WILLARD, or HARVEY LOWINGYER had not been a guest of said motel during said period of time.

Upon examination of a photograph of the blanker reportedly dropped by the assassin of KING found in front of 424 South Main Street, Memphis, Mr. GRIFFIN stated that said blanket did not come from the Linden Lodge.
