

Mr. TALMADOR W. MAITIN /Installation Supervisor U.S. Fixtures Company, Inc., 416. South Main, Memphis, telephone 527-9383, was interviewed at his place of business and at the time advised his home address is 1727 Rockdale Street, Memphic, home telephone 395-7973. was interviewed in the presence of It. CHARLES A. GREECKE. Homicide Bureau, Memphis Police Department.

Mr. MARTIN advised that on the evening of April 4, 1968, he was in the office at U. S. Fixtures Company, Inc., whiting for his salesman to return from a late cervice call. He said he was alone at the time and that the front door was open since he was waiting for a servicemen. MARTH advised he heard a shot, but at the time did not realize it was a shot from a gun. He said he does not know the time because he did not check the clock at that time, but feels cortain it was very close to 6:00 p.m., on April 4, 1988. He explained further that he did not realize it was a shot intomuch as there are apartments above his office and very offer the children knock over chairs, furniture, etc., at times causing very similar noises.

Mr. MARTER commented that he did not pay attention to the activity outside of the building at the time of the shot. He said he turned around afterward to look out the front door to see if his servicemen : was returning. He stated he cannot judge the time and has no way of muncuring it, but feels that within 30 second to as late as two minutes he saw a white man run pasted the front door of his building. said this individual came from the north in the direction of Bulington Street and ran south on the east side of the curottoward the firestation which is located at Satler zud South Main.

Mr. MARTIN stated the white male that ran pastil his front door was running as though he were running to eatch a bus or getting to a store before the doors were closed. He said this individual was not running possibly as fast as he could, but he was not loafing either. He emplained

he has only able to get a glance at this individual who had believed to be rather young. He said as he results this individual had on either a brown suit or brown jacket or the waist up and, therefore, does not know the color of this individual's pants or shoes or if this individual was individual pants or shoes or if this individual was individual ran past the door he did not associate the running of this person with anything or with the shot that he heard. Occurred in the neighborhood until he heard the sizens and saw the police converge on this area. He said it stoned like the police arrived immediately after the shot.

Wr. MARTH was asked if he is cortain that this individual he saw was running from the north to the south on South Main Street in front of his building and he was most emphatic that the individual did run from the north direction to the south direction. Mr. WARTH added he is cortain he would not recognize the individual that ran past his store if he should see him.

He said the individual was running alone because he does not recall sceing anyone close running with him.

Mr. MARTIN stated he does not recall seeing any car drive either way in front of his office other than the police cars that seemed to converge on the area immediately.

Mr. MARTIN stated although he did not see a shoulder patch on the arm of the individual that ran past his door, he said it is likely and possible this individual was a law enforcement official, probably a deputy sheriff, since the Shelby County Sheriff's Office officers wear brown uniforms.
