Mr. LEBUE MARX, Vice-President, Lucky Heart Laboratory, Inc., 390 Mulberry Avenue, Memphis, furnished the following information:

He stated that he left the building at approximately 5:50 to 5:55 p.m. on April 4, 1968, making his exit on the main exit facing Mulberry Street. Mr. MARX said that his car was parked directly in front of this exit, and that he did not hear any noise nor did he observe any persons walking or driving up and down Mulberry or Huling Streets, and did not know of the assassination until arriving at his residence some forty minutes later. Mr. MARX said that the neighborhood around his place of business was quiet as usual at this time, and he could recall nothing out of the ordinary at this time.
