Re Newark teletype to Director, Birmingham, Detroit and Memphis 7:30 AM, 4/8/68, and Cincinnati teletype to Director and Memphis 2:10 PM, 4/5/68.

On 4/11/68, Captain A. C. GILLESS, Homicide Division, Shelby County Sheriff's Office, advised that they have no records of rape cases which might be linked to this case since March 1, 1968.

Inspector N. E. ZACHARY, Homicide Division, Memphis PD, advised that their records reflect one rape case reported on 3/23/68, with one [REDACTED] the victim, female, white, age 19, residing [REDACTED] Memphis. The report reflects she was abducted at Main and Court Streets at gunpoint and was driven to the vicinity of Summer and National Streets in the East Memphis and released after her refusal to their proposition. This incident was not reported to the police department until 3/24/68.
