Re Memphis airtel to Milwaukee, 4/10/68,  
concerning GEORGE B. GAINIE and his son-in-law, "CIBBIE."

Milwaukee indices negative re GEORGE B. GAINIE and "CIBBIE." Indices also negative under spelling variation of GAIENNIE, as noted in the anonymous letter, and under possible variations of "CIBBIE," such as SIBBIE.

Telephone and city directories also negative re afore-mentioned names. Examination also made of various surnames such as SIBILSKI, or CYBIL, etc., wherefrom a nickname such as CIBBIE or SIBBIE could be derived, but no such individuals were residents of Fox Point, Wis., or connected with any local college.

Faculty directories of the University of Wisconsin and Marquette University, both at Milwaukee, also checked negatively in the detail as described in the preceding paragraph.

It is noted that GEORGE B. GAINIE never resided in Milwaukee or Wisconsin. In event this lead may have continued merit and in event it may not already have been set forth for other Divisions, appropriate leads should be
