On 4/10/68, Lt. M. C. SPURLIN, Georgia Bureau of Investigation, telephonically stated that he felt [REDACTED] should be considered as a suspect in the MURKIN investigation as the crime for which [REDACTED] is presently being sought, UFAP - MURDER, was for murder committed with a rifle with telescopic sights. Savannah is origin in the investigation captioned [REDACTED] aka, FUGITIVE, UFAC - MURDER, Savannah File [REDACTED]

Enclosed for the information of Memphis is one copy of the report of SA JAMES H. APPLEGATE at Savannah, 11/30/67.

Particular attention is invited to page 8 of this report, which notes the subject was discharged from the U. S. Coast Guard because of "Psychopathic Personality; Quarrelsomeness". Both Memphis and ~~Savannah~~ ^{Birmingham} received copy of Atlanta report of SA DECLAN J. HUGHES in the captioned matter of 12/23/66, which sets out additional information concerning the subject.

By separate communication the Bureau has been requested to compare the fingerprints of [REDACTED] with any unidentified latent fingerprints in MURKIN case and to advise Memphis and Birmingham.
