While at the hotel he received "strange" telephone calls.

about WILLARD to a local Agent and wanted to know if she could trust them. She was informed she could trust any FBI Agent. She stated that most of the people in that area are racists and that they laugh at her for taking up for President JOHNSON.

Among her comments is the fact that while WILLARD was in the hotel, recollection is to the effect that he received telephone calls from Memphis.

Before I could ask additional questions, she stated she could not afford a telephone call. I informed her an Agent from the San Antonio Office would get in touch with her.
