SUBJECT: MURKIN

On instant date [redacted] a prostitute presently incarcerated at the Portland Jail, Portland, Oregon, upon request was interviewed by SA WILLIAM A. TENWICK, Portland Division. She made available a copy of a letter (one xerox copy enclosed for San Francisco and Memphis) which she received from [redacted] London Lodge Motel, Broadway at 4th Street, Oakland, California. In the letter the following quotation is contained: "I knew whites was going to kill that man," referring to KING.

[redacted] states that she is well acquainted with [redacted] and she insists that [redacted] knows something about the individual who killed KING. She is unable to give any basis for this supposition other than she knows [redacted] so well and this is so "unlike her" that she is confident [redacted] has knowledge of the murder.

[redacted] apparently left Phoenix, Arizona, 3/26/68 for Oakland, California. Under Portland PD File [redacted] she has a prior arrest for prostitution.

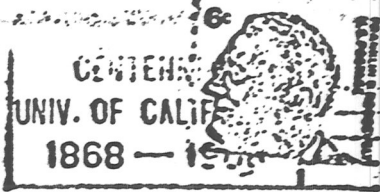
