Re BH telephone call to Mobile Div., 4/8/68, requesting a check on Ala. license 1968, 3-34652.

On 4/8/68, Mrs. CONNIE REDDOCH, Motor Vehicle Bureau, Montgomery, Ala., advised that 1968 Ala. license 3-34652 is registered to RAY H. CLINE, 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, Ala., for a 1959 Ford four-door. This vehicle has identification number B9PT106857 and was registered on 11/2/67, by RAY H. CLINE.

On 4/8/68, Mrs. GERTRUDE KING, Driver's License Bureau, Montgomery, Ala., advised that she could find no record for a driver's license being issued to RAY H. CLINE. She stated, however, that their files reflect a RAY H. CLENE 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, was arrested in Montgomery on 5/15/66, for speeding. He was fined \$15. According to their records he was born on 4/5/20, and had a driver's license number 35615 issued to a TOMMIE ALLEN, St. Stephens, Ala., born 8/5/10 in his possession. Mrs. KING advised that this driver's license issued to TOMMIE ALLEN was revoked on 5/9/63. and this number has not been issued since 1953. She stated that TOMMIE ALLEN, born 8/5/10, has a current Ala. license 1474738, issued on 12/9/53. According to the driver's license he is described as a W/M, 160 pounds, 5' 11", blue eyes, gray hair. In 1953 ALLEN was charged with driving while intoxicated but the charge was reduced to reckless driving and this occurred in Clarke County. He was fined \$123. At that time he was driving a pick-up truck. In 1953 he was employed by Clarke Co. Motors, Jackson, Ala.

The 1968 City Directory contains a listing for RAY H. CLINE, wife LUCILLE E., residing at 3316 Loch Haven Rd., Mo temporery. The directory indicated CLINE to be in the USAF.

Sr. M/Sgt. JOHN MALAHY, Gunter AFB, Montgomery, Ala. a vised that RAY H. CLINE was transferred from this facility of 11/20/67, to their Technical School Sqn. 3380, Keesler Field, Miss. According to their records he was transferred from Keesler Field to APO Seattle, Washington, about three weeks ago.

Mrs. RAY H. CLINE, 3316 Loch Haven, Montgomery, Alabama, advised on 4/8/68, that she and her husband formerly owned a 1959 blue Ford four-door, which had Ala. license for the year 1968 of 3-34652. She stated they sold this vehicle to RAY KINCAID, who was visiting his sister, LUCILLE SPIVEY, 1036 Zephyr Hills Drive, Montgomery. She said that to the best of her recollection KINCAID came to Montgomery about the first of March, 1968, from Cleveland, Ohio, and departed Montgomery on Saturday night, 4/6/68, for his home in Cleveland, Ohio. He was employed by Kershaw Mfg. Co., Montgomery, Ala., while visiting with his sister.

On 4/9/68, Mrs. LINDA BLACKWELL, Secretary, Personnel Dept., Kershaw Mig. Co., 2205 W. Fairview Ave., Montgomery, Ala., advised that according to their records LOWELL RAY KINCAID, 1036 Zephyr Hills, Montgomery, Ala., born 3/8/31, was employed by the firm on 3/13/68, and according to their records is still so employed. She stated, however, that he did not report for work on Monday, 4/8/68 or Tuesday 4/9/68. According to their records he has Social Security No. He indicated he is married and has no children. He was employed as a welder in the welding shop. She said that according to their records KINCAID was employed by the company on 3/9/68, and also worked on 4/3,4,5/68 from 7:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

Mobile indices negative concerling KINCAID and CLINE. Inasmuch as employment records eliminate LOWELL RAY KINCAID no further inquiry being made concerning him.
