SUBJECT: MURKIN

[redacted] (conceal per request), [redacted] West Memphis phoned the Memphis Office and advised as follows;

One [redacted] whom she knows is a likely suspect in the murder because he is anti-negro, irrational, and is violence prone. He has been arrested in Memphis for attempted rape, and for transporting drugs. He was recently charged in West Memphis with attempted rape.

[redacted] comes from Steele, Missouri, although she believes he is living in the Memphis area now, because she saw him recently. He is described as white, male, 26 years old, 5'10" tall, 145 lbs, wears padded suit coats to make him appear larger, and carries a pistol in the glove compartment of his car. He takes drugs, some type of "hop up pills," and when he takes these drugs in combination with his regular diabetes medicine he does some crazy things.

The last time she saw him, which was a number of months ago he had a red car. However, she recently saw a white mustang parked in front of 900 Avalon, West Memphis, where [redacted] visits numerous friends from Steele, Missouri.

She doesn't know [redacted]'s current residence address, and she believes his first name is Charles.
