Re memo of SA JOE W. PHILLIPS dated 4/11/68 at Memphis in captioned file, serial 236. *44-1987-Sub E-236*

On 4/16/68 [redacted] Memphis, telephone [redacted] who is employed as a used car salesman at Jim McDonald Motors, 2466 Summer Ave., telephone [redacted] furnished the following information:

He had observed the composite photograph of an individual in one of the Memphis newspapers regarding captioned case. He stated he desired to furnish information regarding [redacted] (ph) [redacted] who now resides at Atwood, Tenn., who resembles the person in the paper.

He stated that [redacted] formerly lived in Memphis, and in his opinion, is a "crackpot" who had pulled some various insurance-type frauds in Memphis. He stated [redacted] left Memphis about two years ago, at which time he was driving a 1964 Ford Galaxie. [redacted] is supposedly living with his father-in-law, name unknown, in Atwood, Tenn., and left Memphis because he began drinking quite heavily.

He furnished the following description of [redacted]

Race	white
Sex	male
Age	32 to 35, looks younger
Height	6' 3"
Weight	150 to 160 lbs.
Hair	black, combed back straight
Remarks	small-waisted; has a mind of a 14 or 15 year old person
Arrests	believed to have a driving record with Memphis PD or Shelby County SO, but no serious arrests.
