The following is a synopsis of the enclosed inserts:

On the evening of 4/4/68, an anonymous telephone call was received by the New Orleans Office of the FBI. The caller claimed that on 4/3/68, he had overheard [REDACTED] make a statement which the caller felt might have a bearing on the assassination. [REDACTED] was observed to give money to an unknown white male at the Downtowner Motel, Memphis, Tennessee. Hotels and Motels at Alexandria, La., contacted and names of registered guests indicating addresses as Memphis, Tenn., and other areas in Tennessee obtained.
