Dr. WALSH advised Weeburn Country Club disclaimed any knowledge of [redacted] or KISSARRI. Dr. GILBERT ROMAN also of Greenwich Hospital and other members of professional staff, ascertain that composite drawing of assassin of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING strongly resembled [redacted]
