Re Miami teletype to Bureau, Atlanta, Birmingham and Memphis, 4/9/68.

Referenced teletype called attention to the fact that an individual in the Miami Division had stated that JOHN EDWARDS, Hollywood, Florida, is a firearms salesman, and during October, 1967, had been at a firearms show in Memphis and there encountered one J. CONRAD MORGAN, who had purchased a .22 caliber rifle. During the conversation, MORGAN commented he owned a 30.6 caliber automatic rifle. EDWARDS recalls that MORGAN generally fits the description of Unsub appearing in local press stories and artist's conceptions. MORGAN was further described as weird and funny talking.

On 4/13/68, JAMES CONRAD MORGAN, 2097 Imogene, Apt. #4, Memphis, was contacted at his place of business, 153 N. Cleveland.

The following is a description of MORGAN as obtained from observation and interview:
