Re the undated letter addressed to this office by [redacted] and received April 16, 1968.

[redacted] telephoned me on April 9, 1968, at which time she rambled at length as to suggestions for solving the KING murder case. Her voice was that of an extremely old person and her comments were unintelligible. She remarked about some cars not having license plates on both the front and the rear. She thought that if an automobile did not have license plates on both the front and the rear, the driver or the owner of the car should be a suspect.

[redacted] after rambling at length began to cry on the telephone. She definitely is a mental case and had nothing to offer which would be of assistance in connection with solving instant case.
