

AT SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA

At 12:10 AM, April 16, 1968, Agent LARRY NEWMAN, U.S. Secret Service, San Francisco, advised night supervisor SA HANUIS H. WATZLANEK that NEWMAN had just received a telephone call from a LARRY MC GRATH, 28803 Gading Road, Hayward, California (telephone 415-782-9398). MC GRATH is a bartender at the "Blue Dolphin" in San Leandro and worked till about 8:00 PM (April 15, 1968). MC GRATH advised that this evening a man came to the bar whom he described as the suspect in this case. He described him as a white, male, American, 5'7", 160 pounds, curly hair, 25-30 years of age. He wore a dark sports coat, white pants and came in with another white, male, American, 6'1", 220 pounds. MC GRATH stated that he had seen the suspect's picture in the newspaper and that this was the reason for his calling.

MC GRATH stated that he had seen the suspect and the other white, male, American in company of HAROLD EDWARD NICHOLS on a previous occasion. NICHOLS is supposedly known to the FBI and the Secret Service.

MC GRATH told NEWMAN that this evening the suspect came to his bar and he told suspect, "you look like your picture," or "you don't look like your picture" and the suspect replied, "yeh, but I'm a hell of a good shot". KATHY SHERTS, a waitress at the bar was nearby and overheard these remarks.

Efforts by SAs RICHARD J. MC MULLER and WILLIAM BUTCH, JR. to locate MC GRATH immediately following above telephone call was negative. MC GRATH had not returned to his home as late as 2:10 AM.

MC GRATH was telephonically contacted at 6:30 AM, April 16, 1968, and advised he had to attend a union meeting, but would stop at the Hayward Resident Agency after the meeting, at approximately 10:30 AM. At 11:15 AM, MC GRATH telephonically advised that he had to go to work at noon and would not have time to come to the Resident Agency. An appointment was made to meet him at his place of employment, the Blue Dolphin, a first-class San Leandro restaurant, when he finished work at 8:00 PM.
