[REDACTED] advised that he did attend U. S. Naval Reserve Training Session at Camp LeJeune, North Carolina, in March or April of 1966. [REDACTED] advised that at this training session he qualified as an expert with both the M-1 rifle carbine and the .45 caliber automatic service pistol.

[REDACTED] advised that he might have made such a statement as he would like to see MARTIN LUTHER KING killed, but [REDACTED] advised he could not recall for certain whether he made such a statement at the Camp LeJeune Training Session.

[REDACTED] advised he was in Canton, Mississippi, all day on April 4, 1968, and was working with Canton, Mississippi city employees [REDACTED] cleaning a drainage ditch in Canton, Mississippi.

[REDACTED] said he would furnish more names of the city employees if the interviewing Agent anytime in the future thought it was necessary. [REDACTED] advised that no one had ever called [REDACTED] by the first name of [REDACTED]
