SUBJECT: Murkin

At 4:45 am above date, [REDACTED] called and said he was now staying at a flop house at 299 S. Main, room six. He did not want to be contacted at this address. He added that his real address is [REDACTED] where his brother is in a rest home. He also advised that he did not want to be a witness or involved in captioned matter in anyway but wanted to pass on the following information. During September of 1967 a [REDACTED] told him that Marthin L. King would be slain in Memphis and that there would be \$100,000 on his head. [REDACTED] was not too clear on whose head he meant and admitted he was ~~XXXX~~ half drunk while making this call. He added however, that Parham told him his information came out of ~~XXXXXX~~ Alabama.

He added that the last he saw of [REDACTED] was in November, 1967 when [REDACTED] got out of the Shelby County Jail, Memphis, Tenn. [REDACTED] was also served time in the Arkansas State Pen.

[REDACTED] advised that he knew the FBI would look up his [REDACTED] record and see that he was an alcoholic etc. but he wanted to pass on the above information anyway for what it was worth.

[REDACTED] is no doubt ident with the [REDACTED] mentioned in Memphis closed file 91-3332, serial 47.
