GILLIAM feels that if the JIM RAY she knows is dentical with MURKIN subject that he possibly could use his area as hideout.

GILLIAM relates that her mother, VERA BROOKE, 6791 San Diego Road, Buena Park, California, would know owner's identity of this property.

Inasmuch as referenced teletype indicates that JAMES EARL RAY was incarcerated at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Mo., since March 17, 1960, and allegedly confined to that Institution until time of his escape, 4/23/67, this is being furnished to Memphis and Kansas City for info purposes. Possibility exists that "JIM RAY," individual GILLIAM refers to is a possible relative of subject JAMES EARL RAY.
