She is presently employed as a waitress at the Starlight Lounge, Assembly Street. In early 1965 she was living at 2930 Clestnut Street, Columbia South Carolina, with her friend, JOHNNIE BLACKWELL, who was then employed at The Loupge on Lady Street, Columbia, South Carolina. She does not recall ever knowing an individual who owned a 1964 or 1965 Continental and she could furnish no information whatsoever concerning the attempt to purchase a machine gun or a conspiracy to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were shown to her and she was unable to identify this person as anyone known to her.
