MASON, 4017 West Broadway, Louisville, Kentucky, telephonically contacted the Louisville Division advising that in the morning of Saturday, April 13, 1968, while driving in a southbrly direction on Highway 62 near Jeffersonville, Indiana, he observed a white male whom he thought resombled the picture of ERIC STARVO GALT depicted wearing a bow tie as appearing in the local newspapers as well as appearing similar in a side view to the artist's conception of the alleged murderer of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING. This individual was driving an older model black oldsmobile approximately 1960 vintage which bore Indiana license plate 10A1120.

The individual he observed had short cropped dark hair and was wearing what appeared to be dark plastic rimmed glasses. He observed this individual while stopped at a red light at which time the party seemed rather nervous and tried to cover the side of his face with his hand. This occurred hear the Youngstown Shopping Center. MASON further related that the Oldsnobile proceeded from a side street onto Highway 62, near a group of apartments on the north side of Jeffersonville, Indiana.
