4402 44th Street, Ashland, Kentucky, wrote a letter to the Chief of Police, Lafayette, Indiana, advising as follows:

On 4/20/68 she traveled by New York Central train from Chicago. Illinois to Cincinnati, Ohio. She has a very strong reason to believe that RAY was on the train. The man was suspicious looking and said nothing to his companion. The man believed to be RAY and the other man traveling with him got off the train in Lafayette, Indiana. They were met by a woman driving a light or creamy brown Rambler station wagon, about a 1963 or 1964 model. .

Chief of Police has advised that the PD has not been able to identify the car or obtain any other leads as to the identity of the person getting off the train. A display of RAY's photograph at the NYC Station met with negative results.

Louisville interview MISSY FOX, Ashland, Ky., and display photos to her to determine how positive she is of subject's identification. If a positive identification is made, obtain further details she may have that may assist in locating subject and set out appropriate leads to identify and interview the conductor of the train.
