Re Interview of passengers aboard American Airlines Flight 338 from Dallas, Texas to Philadelphia, Pa., on 4/6/68.

Re Oklahoma City airtel to Memphis dated 5/2/68.

The following investigation was conducted at Fort Eustis, Va., by SA H. CURTISS BURRELL, on 5/6/68.

Private TIMOTHY JOHN TAYLOR, was contacted at Ft. Eustis, Va. He advised that he is in Company E of the Second School Battalion, Transportation School Brigade. He advised that he boarded the instant flight 338 at Oklahoma City, Okla., on 4/6/68, with his destination being Philadelphia, Pa. He sat in the most rear seat in the tourist section, next to a white female with blond hair. He was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY with negative results. He advised that he could recall no one on said flight who even resembled RAY. He noted, however, that due to his close attention to the white female with whom he was sitting, that he did not really pay to much attention to any of the other passengers. He stated that due to his seat in the most rear section of the airplane, also, that his observation of all passengers in the tourist section would have been quite limited.

Due to the above, no further investigation being conducted re this matter by Norfolk.
