This man likes the sea; always a different green grass, glamour & color, and a warm atmosphere. The answer is Galveston - a colorful place. It would be nice if you would get him; good publicity, too.

2. He will be found in such movie theatre, not high sounding ones, like Paramount, etc. He was there only in afternoons until dark. I noticed him as he appears unassuming, quiet, not troublesome. These are reasons he has not been apprehended.
