Re Savannah airtel to Birmingham dated 4/17/68.

[REDACTED] Savannah, Ga., reappeared at the Savannah Office on 4/30/68 at which time he confidentially advised that [REDACTED] DAVID KENNEDY, residing in Birmingham, Ala, and who is a member of the National Guard in the State of Alabama. He stated that while he does not know KENNEDY's address, he is aware of the fact that KENNEDY has expressed bitterness toward the Negroes in the area in view of his claim that they caused him to be called to active duty in the National Guard on several occasions to quell disturbances.

He pointed out that in addition, [REDACTED] (FNU) RAY [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] that they reside in Birmingham, Ala., at an unknown address. He said that the only reason he was bringing this information to the attention of this Office regarding RAY was because of his last name being the same as subject RAY being sought in this case.

He pointed out that to the best of his recollection, RAY is white male, between 28 and 32 years of age, slender build, approximately 5'8".
